DRUM NOTATION LEGEND

- CRASHES ...:** Three symbols representing crashes: a quarter note with a vertical line through the stem and a star on the note head, a quarter note with a vertical line through the stem and a downward-pointing arrow on the note head, and a quarter note with a vertical line through the stem and a star on the note head.
